REGULATIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL DEAF CHESS EVENTS OF THE I.C.S.C.  
ARTICLE VI - The Intercontinental Cup of the I.C.S.C. Championships page 29

- 3.1. The Club of each country must correspond to the following condition:
  - 3.1.1. The Champion of the official club championship of its country.
  - 3.1.2. The Club championship of the country must be is officially calculation by FIDE rating.
- 3.2. After begin championship of the country necessary during three days to inform ICSC Secretary-General on undertaking the event.
- 3.3. ICSC Secretary-General informs on ICSC web-site about undertaking the club championship of the country, which has notified him of event.
- 3.4. The Composition of the club:
  - 3.4.1. Three main players given club must live according to stamp in passport in region, in which is found club.
  - 3.4.2. It is allowed comprise of composition of the club of one player from the other region of the country.
  - 3.4.3. Attraction of one foreign player is allowed according to stamp in passport.
  - 3.4.3. Three main players of the club are obliged to participate in national championship of its country.
- 3.5. In the event of absence of official information on undertaking the club championship of the country - - a club is not allowed on ICSC Continental club championship.

*“On ICSC web-site in section "Ratings", it is more appropriate to write "**Ratings**". Also, instead of "ICSC / FIDE Ratings", it is more appropriate to write "**FIDE Ratings & Titles / ICSC Titles**".*

***Reason:** The International Chess Federation (FIDE) does not permit I.C.S.C to use its ratings name”*

Not allowed anonymous signature in messages on the ICSC web-site to hold meetings of the ICSC Board after 2-3 months.”
