### **XIII. World Individual Deaf Chess Championships for Men III. World Individual Deaf Chess Championships for Women I. World Individual Deaf Chess Championships for Juniors II. International Deaf Chess Open Tournament XXVII. I.C.S.C. Congress**

#### **General Information:**

We would like to inform all participating countries that we have received entries of 88 chess players for the WC and the Open-Tournament. A list of participants for the individual competitions is enclosed. Altogether about 175 people (guests, congress, helpers, ICSC-board) have announced their participation in this great event in written form.

#### **Important things:**

Countries that will arrive prior to 23 July 2004 and/or depart after 05 August 2004 have to arrange accommodation for those earlier or later days themselves. The Sport- und Bildungszentrum has only been booked from 23 July till 05 August 2004.

#### **Accommodation and meals:**

The Sport- und Bildungszentrum at Malente is completely booked for the time of the WC. We would like to remind you that the countries Italy, Poland, Russia, Switzerland, Latvia, Iceland and Kazakhstan haven't made reservations at the Sport- und Bildungszentrum Malente and that they will have to arrange their accommodation by themselves. Uzbekistan has entered 9 people but made reservations for accommodation and meals only for 2 people and therefore has to arrange accommodation for the other 7 persons itself.

If there should be any other countries that will need visa to come to Germany we ask them to inform us immediately so that we can handle this matter in time.

### **Participants:**

Only national champions and ICSC-grandmasters of each country are eligible for the chess WC. There is no limitation neither for participation in the junior event nor for the open tournament. Presentation of a valid audiogram is necessary for all players. Lots for all games will be drawn according to the FIDE referees during the Technical Meeting. We ask the countries to review the enclosed list of participants and inform us about mistakes. The men's competition will be played 11 rounds (new!) (see enclosed programme).

### **Congress:**

On Sunday 01 August 2004 the 27<sup>th</sup> ICSC congress will be held on location. The invitation for the congress will be made by the ICSC-board.

### **Arrival and departure:**

We have enclosed a final feedback-form and ask you to fill it in. You have to give detailed information about your arrival and departure to avoid problems in transport from Hamburg airport respectively Bad Malente-Gremsmühlen station.

### **Participant's identification cards:**

Each participant of the world-chess-championships will receive an identification card. This card will carry a photograph of the participant.
